Disclaimer

This guide assumes that you are familiar with PHP and WordPress development and API's used in WordPress and that you have some development experience working with WordPress. There will be no explanations on how to use specific filters or actions, that is basic WordPress development practice.

Cleanup Hooks

These hooks can be used for cleanup and reset tools.

Direct Cleanup Request Hooks

There are two hooks that are executed when process starts and finishes. Each one sends scope (site or network) and tools type (cleanup or reset):

- `sct_request_ajax_cleanup_start`
- `sct_request_ajax_cleanup_finish`

Scheduled Cleanup Request Hooks

There are two hooks that are executed when process starts and finishes. Each one sends scope (site or network) and tools type (cleanup or reset):

- `sct_request_cron_cleanup_start`
- `sct_request_cron_cleanup_finish`

Usage Example

Here is the example how to hook into the cleanup process before the cleanup starts:

```
add_action('sct_request_ajax_cleanup_start', 'my_cleanup_start', 10, 2);
```

```
function my_cleanup_start($scope, $purpose) {  
    // do what you need to do before cleanup starts  
}
```

Disable Tools

Additional hooks are available to allow you to disable some of the plugin tools. Each filter here passes a list of tools to disable. Each tool is represented by the tool code that can be found in the **load.php** file in methods with names starting with **get_tools_**.

Direct Clean / Reset Disable Hooks

Site Cleanup Tools: **sct_disable_cleanup_tools_site**

Site Reset Tools: **sct_disable_cleanup_tools_reset**

Network Cleanup Tools: **sct_disable_cleanup_tools_network**

Network Reset Tools: **sct_disable_cleanup_tools_netreset**

Scheduled Clean Disable Hooks

Site Cleanup Tools: **sct_disable_cleanup_tools_schedule_site**

Network Cleanup Tools: **sct_disable_cleanup_tools_schedule_network**
